



In Pursuance of a warrant dated the 13th day of October 1760 I did on the 20th day of August 1771 Survey for the Honble Proprietaries a Small Island in the River Schuykill Opposite the Land late Robert Jones's Dec'd and just below Mount Anaret Fall which Contains Sixty perches, And also a Small Sand Barr Containing Twenty perches.

N.B. This is made an Island by the Boat Channel being cut between it and the Shore
