the Bearer Adam Holman wants to agree with the Proprietaries for a Small Island in Schuykill River opposite to John Buckwalters and Daniel Longanecker but as there is no Draught of the same in the Survr. Genl. Office you are Desired to Survey and Return the same into the Surveyor Generals Office in pursuance of the Proprietaries Warrant granted for all the Islands in the Rivers Schuykill and Susquehanna Dated the ^{13th} ~~14th~~ of October 1768. Holman paying you the Surveying fees.
