

Philadelphia 15th. Novr. 1758.

Mr. Bertram Galbreath. As your Brother is over Susquahanna I must get you to make a regular Survey of the Island called Jonass Island containing as I am told about fifty acres more or less & return it to the Honble Proprietary yt it may be leased to your Father on such Terms as shall be agreed on. I am Sir

The Survey made in Pursuance of the above order is accepted by me & filled in my Office the 13th October 1760. in order to be returned into the Secretarys office for the use of the the Proprietaries.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of MAY 1910
