




Philada. 7th. Decr 1749.  
 Richard Peters & Lynford Lardner Agents of the  
 Honourable Proprietaries of Pennsylvania do agree to  
 Lett to Henry Coat & Samuel Stevenson in Fee Simple for  
 Five hundred Pounds. Money of Pennsylvania or Jersey  
 Proclamation to be paid on the Twenty fifth Day of March  
 next, the Tract of Twelve hundred & fifty Acres. No. 50.  
 Lying on an Indian Path on both sides of Paquass River  
 adjoining Robert Strettetts' Land in Morris County West  
 Jersey & we the said Henry Coat & Samuel Stevenson do  
 agree to pay to the said Richard Peters & Lynford Lardner  
 for the use of the said Proprietaries of Pennsylvania. the  
 said Sum of Five hundred Pounds on or before the 25th  
 of March next. Witness our Hands and Seals this Seventh  
 Day of December 1749.
