Dated the 19th of the 9th Month Anno 1716. Surveyd and Laid
out unto James Steel a Lot of Ground [in Right of an original
purchase of Two hundred and fifty acres made of the
Proprietor by William Briant] Bounded on the North
with Mulberry Street on the East with the End of a Second
Street lot On the South with William Hards Lot. On the West
with the Third Street from Delaware. Being in Breadth on
the said Third street fifty one foot and in Length on
Mulberry Street. One hundred foot. Surveyd this 26th day
of the 9th Month 1716
