

Surveyd the 28th day of December 1730 by virtue of a warrant dated the 30th day of October 1730. unto James Steel of the City of Philadelphia a certain lot of Ground in the said City [in Right of William Boswells Purchase of 500 acres] lying between Sassafras Street and Vine Street bounded westward with the third Street from Delaware on the North with other ground of the said James Steel on the East with the ends of Second Street Lots and on the South with the said James Steels lot in Right of Joseph & Daniel Milner being ¹⁷/₁₆ breadth on the said third Street one hundred and thirty three feet and in Length One hundred ninety five feet Returned into the Secretaries Office the 22 d of January 1730.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Second day of August 1910
