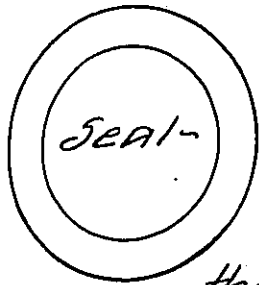


PENNSYLVANIA S.S.



By the Proprietaries.

At the Request of James Steel & Samuel Powell of the City of Philadelphia. That we would Grant them a Resurvey on a Tract of Land Scituate on the East Side of the River Schuylkill between the Land first Laid out to Jacob Pellison afterwards to Col^l. William Markham and the London Company's Land first Survey'd & Confirm'd to John Tyzack for nineteen hundred and Sixty eight Acres and Since by Sundry Conveyances the Same is now vested in the said James Steel & Samuel Powell.

These are to authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed unto the said James Steel & Samuel Powell the Said Tract of Land according to the Scituation, Bounds and discription aforesaid and make Exact Return thereof into the Secretarys Office for which this shall be thy Sufficient warrant Given under my hand & the Lesser Seal of our Province at Philadelphia the 31st day of Decemr. Anno Dom 1733.
