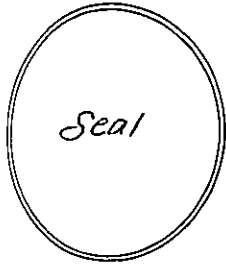

By ye Comission <sup>rs.</sup> impowerd to grant Lotts in ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye Request of Matthew Perin in right of Francis Harford Purchaser of Two hundred & fifty Acres, y<sup>t</sup> we would grant him to take up his Lott & Land <sup>th</sup> win ye Liberties: These are to will & require thee in ye Proprietarys Name forth<sup>th</sup> to Survey or cause to be Surveyd unto him his Proportion of Land <sup>th</sup> win ye Bounds thereof & a Lott in ye City, he fencing it in & building upon ye Same <sup>th</sup> win Six Months from ye Date of Survey, & make returns thereof into ye Secretarys Office, Given at Philadelphia ye 24<sup>th</sup> 7br 1684.
