



In pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the first day of December 1726 - I did on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of 8<sup>br</sup> 1728 Survey and lay out for John Packer two Lot of Ground in the City Philadelphia in Right of the Purchase of John Boy Each lot being in breadth Twenty Six foot and one half and being Contiguous make a piece of Ground of fifty three foot in breadth and ~~three~~ three hundred and Six foot in length bounded Southward with the High Street and Westward with the Ninth Street from Delaware.
