At the Request of John Parsons of Wrights Town That we would Grant him to take up the quantity of One Hundred Seventy Nine Acres of Land the remainder untaken up of five Hundred Acres the Original purchase made of the late Proprietor by Joseph Hall whose Heirs or descendants have Granted the Same unto the Said John Parsons — These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in the aforesaid Right — According to the Method of Townships appointed in this Province the said Quantity of One Hundred Seventy nine Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation.
