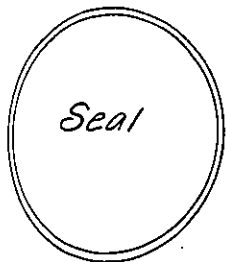

At the Request of ~~George Pierce~~ Richard Pierce That we would grant him to take up One Hundred Acres of Headland in right of himself and his Wife who came into this Province Servants to William Stanly in the Year 1682 and served their time duly as by Certificate appears, These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the S^d Rich^d Pierce the Said quantity of One hundred Acres of Land, that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up, nor is concealed nor Seated by the Indians (he paying for the same one half penny Sterling Yearly for every Acre to the Prop^r or his Ord^r) and make Returns into the Gen^l Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} Where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by the Secretary, Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} y^e 17th of the 3^d Moth 1705
