These are to will and require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to Survey or cause to be  
Survey'd unto him <sup>be</sup>yond SKULL Kill on ye Northside of Darbey Creek,  
ye sd Number of Acres in a place not already taken up according  
to ye method of Townships appointed by me & make returns thereof  
into my Secretarys Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 24<sup>th</sup> of ye 17<sup>th</sup> 1683.
