

By virtue of a Warrant from Edward Shippen, Griffith Owen, and James Logan Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>d</sup> Month 1705, Surveyd and Laid out the 23<sup>d</sup> of the Same month and year unto Joseph Paul a Lot of Ground in the City of Philadelphia (in Right of Edward Blendman's purchase of One thousand acres) bounded Southward with the High Street Eastward with a Line twenty Six feet <sup>8 1/2</sup> from the ffifth Street from Delaware and Parallel thereunto and Westward with a Vacant Lot being in breadth twenty Six feet and a half and in length three hundred and Six feet
