At the Request of Isaac Penington that We would Grant him to take up the Quantity of ffive Hundred Acres of Land in this Province the Original Purchase of Thomas Ellwood made of the late Proprietor by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the four & Twenty & five & Twentieth dayes of the Month Called January Anno 1681 who by his Last Will & Testament dated the 21st day of the month called August Anno 1712 Did Give and bequeath the Same unto the Said Isaac Penington his Heir & Assignes forever These are to Authorize & Require thee ~~thee~~ to Survey or cause to be Surveyd unto the said Isaac Penington in the said Province according to the Method of Townships appointed the said Quantity of ffive hundred Acres of Land (the proportion of Liberty Land being first deducted) that has not been already Surveyd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returnes thereof into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our Hands & the lesser Seal of ye Province at Philadelphia the 20th day of the Third Month Anno Din 1725
