At the Request of ^{Francis} Daniel Pastorius that we would Grant him to take up Eight hundred Ninety and three Acres of Land in this Province at the rate of Seven pounds 7p hundred to be paid to the Proprietor: These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to ye Said H. D. Pastorius the Said quantity of Land in this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is Seated by the Indians, And make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office, Given under hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the fifth day of the Sixth Month August A.D. 1713
