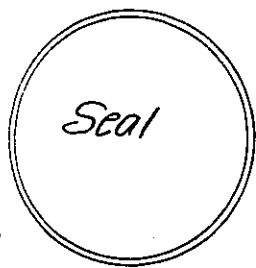


Pennsylvania S.S.

These are to authorise and require you to Survey and lay out for our use in Five hundred Acre Tracts any Lands on or near the East Branch of Susquehanna whereon there are any kind of Mines or Minerals And to make Returns of the same unto our Secretary's Office, And for so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant, Witness John Penn Esq^r Lieutenant Governor & Commissioner of Property of the said province who by virtue of certain powers from the said Proprietaries hath hereunto set his Hand and caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this twenty third Day of December Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty eight. —
