Personally appeared before us the Subscriber two of the Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid Jacob May of Chanceford Township in the County of York, who upon his solemn oath doth depose and say that three certain Brush Islands in Conostogoe Township in Lancaster County situate in the River Susquehanna, and adjoining each, and being immediately above Burkholders Island and within Fifteen Perches of the western shore of the Susquehanna are vacant, and that this Deponent has improved the same by clearing about six acres of Land on the same. The same Islands being commonly known by the Name of Mays Islands. and further this deponent saith not. given under our Hands and Seals November the first 1796.
