ed a part of y^e said Bank, Assuring they will Maintain y^e said Bank, and performe all such other Regulation with all Convenient Speed, According to the Proprietors method in his ffirst Constitution in y^e Like Case

These are therefore in y^e Proprietors name to will and Require thee fforthwith to Survey or Cause to be Survey'd unto y^e afforesaid persons y^e Number of fffeet and in such place as is hereafter Mentioned, that is to say, unto W^m Carter Twenty Nine feet, beginning at y^e North side of y^e Bank lott of Griff Jones's and ffrom thence along the Bank of y^e Towne on Delaware River Side *Southward before y^e ffront lotts of ~~forty five feet~~ Twenty nine feet Unto Robert Longshore, beginning at y^e north side of W^m Carters bank lott and proceeding as before ffifty fffeet. Unto Henry Wood beginning at y^e north side of Rob^t Longshores Bank lott proceeding as before Thirty fffeet. and to Barnaby Willcox beginning at y^e north side of Henry Woods Bank lott proceeding as before Thirty fffeet and to Tho Tress beginning at y^e north side of Barnaby Willcox's Bank Lott proceeding as before ten fffeet And Whereas y^e Said Thomas ~~the~~ Tress hath made appeare that he hath purchased a ffourth part of y^e ffront Lott
