in y<sup>e</sup> Method of Townships appoynted by y<sup>e</sup> Govern<sup>t</sup>, next  
unto former warrants on the back of those already settled  
by y<sup>e</sup> river Delaware above the ffalls and make return  
unto me, of their originall field works, & protracted figures,  
which are to remaine on Record in my Office, Philadelphia  
y<sup>e</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1683
