



James Hendricks Land at Conestogo beginning at the Mouth of a Run by the ford over the 5th Creek thence up the 5th Creek Traversing the several Courses thereof 950 perches to a white oak thence south by East by y^e Land of Thomas Baldwin 115 perches to a black oak thence west south west by the Land of John Hendricks 176 perches to a Hickery thence South by East by the same Land 195 perches to a post thence west south west by the Land of David Priest 20 perches to a post thence Northwest 14 perches to a white oak by y^e first Mentioned Run thence down the same 231 perches to the place of Beginning - Containing 300 acres with the usual allowance of 6 p^{er} C.
