

By Vertue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property bearing date the 8th day of 9th 1703 for resurveying unto Adam roads a Tract of land Scituate in the East town in the County of Chester laid out to James Claypool in right of his first Original purchase for one Thousand acres and since Conveyd to the said Adam Roads. Resurveyd the 22^d of the 12th 170th¹⁰⁰₄ unto the said Roads a Tract of land withⁱⁿ the bounds of y^e Welch tract in the County of Chester Beginning at a post in Newtown line and Extending by Thomas Masseys Land Michael Tobson's Land and vacants Land North twenty one degrees west Nine hundred and six perch to a post then North east by East two hundred and sixteen perches Then south South East by the Lands of Richard Thomas and David Evans Nine hundred and ~~one hundred and~~ six perches to a post. Then by the said Newtown line South west by west two hundred and forty perches to the place of the Beginning Containing One thousand two hundred and sixty eight acres
