By Virtue of a Warr<sup>t</sup> to me directed from the Prop<sup>r</sup>s Com<sup>rs</sup> dated y<sup>e</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1694. I do hereby authorize and Impower thee to Lay out unto John Roberts of Philadelphia County one hundred and fifty Acres of Land, where not already taken up, being to make up his five hundred acres w<sup>ch</sup> he purchased, and make Returne thereof into the ~~Survey~~ Surv<sup>r</sup> Generalls Office, and this shall be thy Warr<sup>t</sup> dated at Philadelphia the 16<sup>th</sup> day of the sixth Month 1694
