These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto the Said Alexander Ross in the ~~the~~ ^{County} afore-said ~~the~~ according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said Quantity of five Hundred acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make a Returne thereof into the Secretary's office in Order to a further Confirmation Which Survey in case the said Alexander fulfill the above agreement within three Months after Location shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted Given under our Hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia y^e 5th day of the 9th Month A.D. 1714.
