



By vertue of a warrant from the Comissioners of property dated the 20 of the 2^d mo 1702 directed unto me to resurvey a certaine tract of Land Laid out for Mouns Cocke for 300 acrs within the bounds of Letitia Penns Mann - ob - this is to Certify that I have resurveyd the above sd tract acording to the bounds thereof begining at a w. O. K. being a Corner of John Rambos Land on the west side of Schulkeel then by the said River North ⁶⁰ degrees West 32 perches then North 70 degrees West 72 perches to a Hictry marked by the said River then by an old Line of marked trees west south west five hundred and fourty perches to a post then ~~by~~ by a Line of marked trees South south East Ninty five perches to a Corner of Mathias Houlstons Land then by a Line of marked trees and the said Land with the said John Rambos Land East ^{East} North 592 perches to the plac of begining Containing 336 acrs and 36 perches Resurveyd by me - - David Powell

the Interlining between the 5th and 6th Lines is the first and true Lines of survey.) My Respected friend Jacob Taylor be pleased ^{too} accept of my poor scribline by thy Respected friend A.T.
