



In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Trustees of the free Society of Traders dated the 25th of March 1724 There was Survey'd to David Lloyd Esq^r a Certain piece of Land situate in Unchanlan in the County of Chester

Begining at a Hickery in a line of John Bower's Land thence North by West by the same ten pches to a corner then west by south by s^d Bower's Land 40 pches to a post thence North West by Vacant Land 52 pches to a Hickery thence North East by the Land of Joseph phipps David Davies & Rees Jones 145 pches to a post thence south East by James Edwards's Land 82 pches to a Black Oak thence South West by vacant Land 117 pches to the place of Begining Containing Seventy acres and ^{proportionable part of the} the Usual allowance of Six p Cent for Roads & Difference of Surveys —
