



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 2^d day of May 1719 Surveyed and Laid out for John Humstad a Certain Tract of Land Scituate in the County of Philadelphia on a branch of Percuornie Creek beginning at a white oak in Jacob Price's line thence by Land reputed the Societies North west Two hundred and Seventy perches to a post being a ~~post~~ Corner of Derick Johnsons Land thence by the Same North East one hundred Eighty Nine ~~perches~~ perches to a hickery thence by Vacant Land ^{South East} Two hundred and Seventy perches to a post thence South west by Vacant Land and Land of Said Price one hundred Eighty Nine perches to the place of beginning Contain- ing three hundred acres with Allowance of Six p Cent. - Surveyed March 26th 1723 p. Nich^o Scull.
