The House on this Lot is very ordinary, so of the other buildings - it is very good Land full of small Young Timber Westward to ab^t 180⁰ from whence it is very stony & brushy to the end of the Line, & on the whole Distance on the 55^oW Course is of the same sort of brushy bad Ground. Cleared on it ab^t 6 acres - he has lived on the Land ab^t two Years - No Meadow nor Water.
