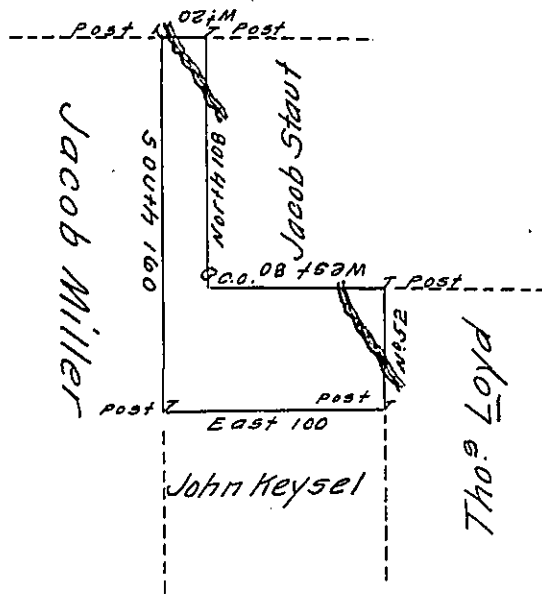


VACANT LAND
