



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate partly in Richland and partly in Springfield Townships, in the County of Bucks and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing Sixty five acres and 128 Perches of Land, together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Being Part of a Tract called Lottery Land. Surveyed in Pursuance of an Order from the Surveyor General dated the 3<sup>d</sup> february last past.. for Peter Gruber on the 24<sup>th</sup> february Anno - 1773.

Notandum - As to its quality the Land is stony and in some Parts very Rocky. yet about 30<sup>acs</sup> of it may be Tilled. The rest is indifferently well Timbered. There is no more Meadow ground on it then about Three quarters of an Acre in one piece adjoining Stephen Ackermans Land. and another Piece of about One hundred Perches adjoining Casper Gross's Land.. There is neither Run nor Spring on the Place That holds Water in dry Seasons.
