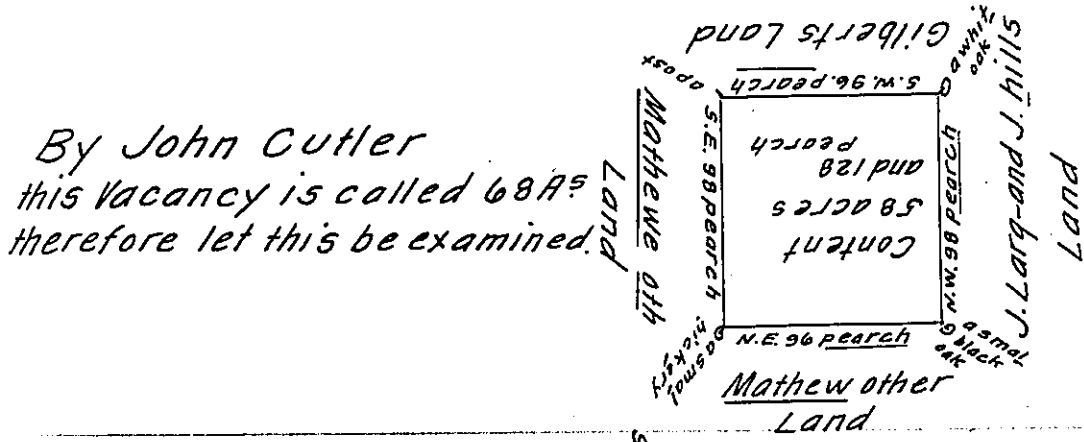
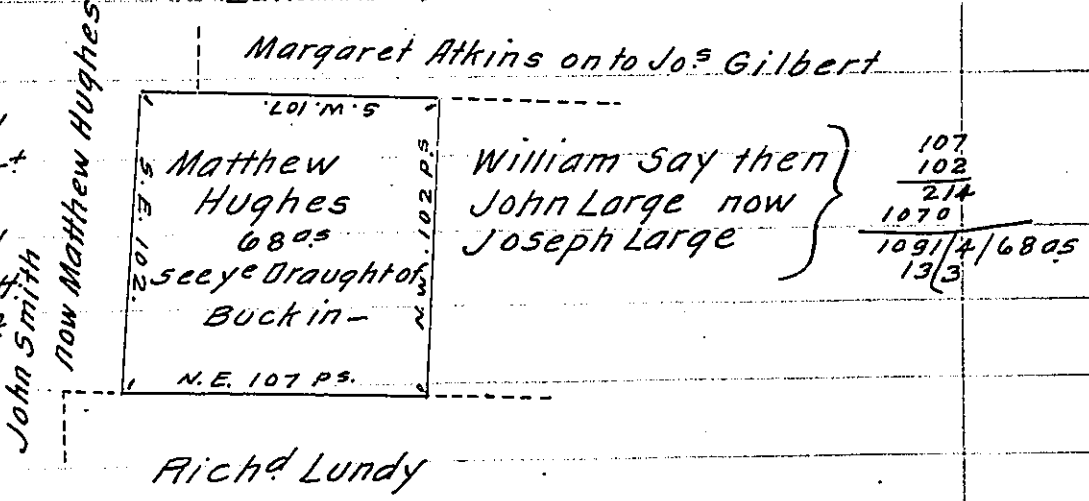


This Tract of Land surveyed at the Request of the Proprietor and Mathew Hews upon the 13 day of the 1 month - 1732:3 -
