



By virtue of a Warrant from the Honourable the Proprietaries dated the Twelfth day of May 1732. Surveyed to the Honourable Thomas Penn Esq^r The above described tract of land situate on ye east side of the River Schuylkill about six miles above the mouth of Maiden Creek in the County of Philadelphia containing 628 acres with the usual allowance of six p Cent.

Surveyed the 18th day of Novem^r 1734 by Nich^s Scull.

Returned into the Proprietaries Secretary's Office the 14th day of May Anno Domi 1746.
