Whereas it hath ^{been} represented to us by David McCornaughy of the County of York Esq^r One of the presbyterian Congregation in the Manor of Maske and Township of Cumberland in the said County. That a Meeting house was erected by the said Congregation on a Tract of One hundred acres of land in the said Manor and Township about eighteen years ago which has been ever since used & enjoyed by them And that they are now desirous and have humbly besought us to grant to the said David McCornaughy and Hance Hamilton, Robert McPherson, Samuel Eddy & John Buchanan all Members of and in trust for the said Congregation our warrant for the surveying to them the said One hundred acres of land for the Use aforesaid on their agreeing to pay to our Use the then common Terms of fifteen pounds ten shillings & Hundred acres and One halfpenny Sterling & acre Quit Rent with Interest & Quit Rent from the first of March 1747 And we favouring their request. These are to require you to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said David McCornaughy Hance Hamilton Robert McPherson Samuel Eddy and John Buchanan at the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the said Quantity of One hundred acres & make return thereof into the Secretaries Office in Order for Confirmation to the said David McCornaughy Hance Hamilton Robert McPherson Samuel Eddy & John Buchanan In Trust for the use aforesaid for which this shall be your sufficient warrant: Provided they fulfill the above agreement within six Months from the date hereof Given under my Hand & the Seal of the Land Office by virtue of certain powers from the said proprietaries at Philadelphia this twenty fifth day of May One Thousand seven hundred & sixty five.
