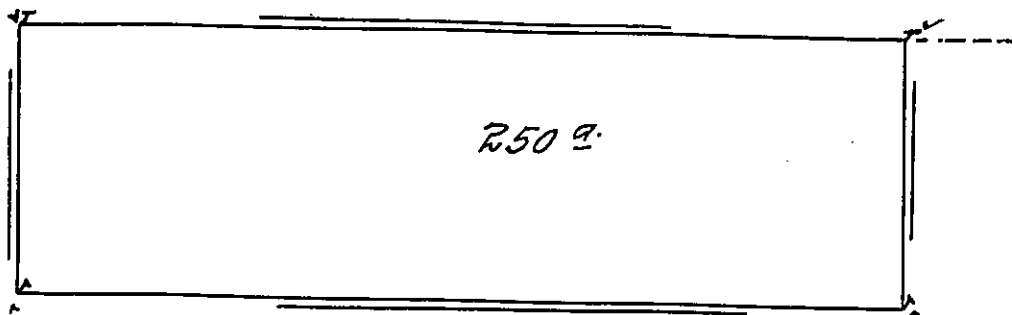


Humphrey Morry's Land.



Surveyd for Andrew Hamilton a tract of land situate in the County of Philad^a beginning at a corner past of Humphrey Morry's Land thence by the same North East three hundred Eighty five perches to a post Thence by Vact Land South east One hundred & Ten perches to a post thence South West three hundred Eighty five perches to a post Thence Northwest One hundred & Ten perches to the place of beginning containing Two hundred & fifty acres with allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent Surveyed April 18th 1728.
