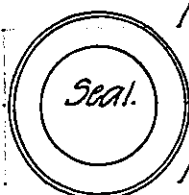


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Andrew Hamilton of the City of Philadelphia Gent. That we would grant him a resurvey on a certain Tract of land Situate on Little Creek in the County of Kent being part of a larger Tract called Simpsons Choice purchased by the said Andrew of the Executor of John Richardson of the said County Deced. and now held by him for about two hundred acres. These are to authorize and require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyd unto the said Andrew Hamilton the said Tract of land according to the former lines and Divission thereof, <sup>and bound it on ye said Creek.</sup> and make exact returns of the same into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation. Given under our Hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25<sup>th</sup> day of ye first Month Anno Dom 1719.
