

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 27th day of the 1st month 1700 I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed unto Edward Hopton in right of Richard Jordain old Purchaser a certain Tract of Land situate in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a stake sett up in the Line of Richard Whitpain and Company's Land and running along the said Line North East three hundred and six perches to another stake sett up in the said Line from thence South East by a Line of marked trees 131 perches to another stake sett in the ground from thence South West by a Line of marked trees three hundred and six perches to a fourth stake sett in the ground and from thence North West by a Line of marked trees one hundred thirty and one perches to the place of beginning containing and laid out for two hundred and fifty acres of Land Surveyed the 14th day of the 9th month 1700 and Returned according to the abovesaid survey and bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 12th day of the 10th month 1700.
