By Vertue of a war^t from y^e Proprietary and Govern^r, Bearing Date y^e 2^d of y^e 9th Mo^o Last Directed to me, I hereby Certifie in to his Secretaryes office y^t I have Caused to be Surveyed and set out y^e 4th of y^e 10th Mo^o with obl^d Hard: R: a Lott in y^e City of Philadelphia Scituated Between High Street and Mulberry Street formerly Called Holme Street, Containing in Breadth thirty foot and in Length one Hundred Ninty five foot, Bounded North ward wth a Vacant Lott East ward wth back Lotts, Southward wth a Vacant Lott, West ward wth y^e third Street from Delaware and is Accordingly Entered and Recorded in my office Philadelphia this 19th of y^e 4th Mo^o 1684.
