

Beginning at a Post by a small run of wa obl it from the Proprietors Manor of Springettsbury obl up the said run Seventeen Perches & a half to a obl at a Corner of John Holmes's land thence north one Degree East by said Holmes's land forty Perches to a Post by Vine Alley or Street of thirty three feet broad, thence by said Alley South Eighty one degrees East fourteen Perches & eight feet to a Corner Post thence by a road of Fifty feet broad dividing it from Danl Pegs land South one degree, west thirty four Perches to the place of beginning. Beginning at a Post at a corner of Geo: Fitzwaters land by a small run of water dividing this from the Proprietaries Manor of Springettsbury then up the said run Thirteen Perches to a post at a corner of Edward Roberts's land then north One degree East by the said Roberts's land forty five Perches to a Post by Vine Alley, then by the same South Eighty One degrees East obl Perches & Nine feet to a Post at another obl of the said Geo: Fitzwaters's land, then obl same South one degree West forty Perches to the place of Beginning.

The above Description was taken from a Deed belonging to William Wishart for the Lot he has on the North side of Pegs Run.
