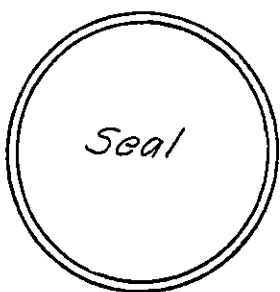

*Whereas In pursuance of a Warr^t from my Comm^{rs} of Property bearing date y^e 19th
of the 10th Month 1684 there was surveyd for Trial Holme son to Thomas Holme
late Surveyor Gen^l of this Province &c a Tract of Land laid out ^{in Dublin Township} for five hundred
Acres in right and as part of Rich^d Corsly his Original purchase of one thousand
Acres but was never returned into the Secretaries Office These therefore are to
Require thee forthwth to make Regular Return of the said Survey into the said
Office in pursuance of the Warr^t afores^d for w^{ch} this shall be thy Authority.
Given under my hand and Seal at Philad^{ia} the 11th day of 8^{ber} 1701
