



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property Dated the — Day of — 1725
 Surveyed and laid out for Rowland Ellis a Certain Tract of land in the County of
 Philadelphia near Perkiomie in Right of Daniel Wharley beginning at a White oak
 being a Corner of John Ledrahs Land thence by that and Land of Tillman Golph
 and Vac^t Land ^{South West} three hundred and Eighteen perches to a post then North West One
 hundred and Sixty perches to a post in John Pawlins Lite thence by the said Pawlins
 Land and Vac^t Land North East three hundred and Eighteen perches to a Post
 (obliterated) South East One hundred and Sixty perches to the place of
 beginning Containing three hundred Acres with Allowance of Six P. Cent Surveyd
 March the 27th 1726 P. Nicholas Scull
