 the 3^d & 4th dayes of April anno 1695 whose Eldest Son and Heir Daniel Wharley by Indentures of
 Lease & Release dated the 2^d & 3^d dayes of April anno 1724 Granted and Released the whole unto
^{y^e} said Rowland Ellis his Heirs & assignes forever These are to Authorize & Require thee to
 Survey or cause to be Survey'd ~~in Right~~ of the Original purchase aforesaid according to
 the Method of Townships appointed in the said Province the said quantity of three Hundred
 Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the
 Indians and make Returns thereon into the Secretary's Office in Order for a further
 Confirmation Given under our Hands & the lesser Seal of the Province at Philad^o the 21st day
 of y^e third Month anno D^r 1725
