



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 21st Day of the 3^d Mo. 1725 Surveyed for Rowland Ellis a Tract of land Scutuate Near Oley in the County of Philad. beginning at a Post being a Corner of the Swedes Tract thence by the same South Twenty Degrees West One hundred and Eighteen perches to a post thence by Vac^t land North Seventy Degrees west One hundred Eighty & Eight perches to a Post then by land of George Boon and Vac^t land ^{North East} Two hundred Twenty and Eight perches to a post then by land of Isaac Leonard South Seventy Degrees East Two hundred Thirty Six perches to a Black oak in the line of Geo. Shires land thence by y^e same South Twenty ^{deg} west Ninety Two perches to y^e said Swedes Tract thence by the same North Seventy Degrees West One hundred and forty perches to y^e place of beginning Containing Two hundred and fifty Acres with the usual allowance laid out December the 2^d 1725
