of Pennsilvania & ^r Territories thereunto belonging.

At ^r Request of Edward Erberry Purchaser of five hundred acres ^r we would grant
him to take up his Lott in ^r City & Land in ^r Liberties of ^r City proportionable on
Delaware side. These are therefore in the Proprietary's Name to will & require thee
forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him his said Lott & Liberty Land
as aforesaid, he fenceing in & building upon his City Lott, & improveing his Liberty
Land, according to Regulation, and make returns thereof into the Govern^r
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ^r 6th 10th mo 1684
