By Vertue of a War^t from Edward Pennington Survey^r General beareing dat the 30th of y^e 10th m^o 1700 directed unto me I hereby Certiefy into his Office that I have Surveyd and Laid out unto Richard Haines a pecc of Land within the Liberty of Philadelphia begineing at a Corner Stak being a Corner deviding it from John Simcocks Land in a Line of William Wartnoers Land from from thenc by y^e said Line West 71 1/2 perch to another Stak in y^e said Line from thenc South 112 perch to another Stak from thenc East 71 1/2 perch obl another Stak sett in the ground from thenc^{obl} obl a Line of marked trees 112 perches to y^e place of begineing Containeing and Laid out for fifty acers of Land 4th of y^e 11th m^o 1700
