By virtue of the Commissioners Warr^t dated y^e 30th of y^e 5th mo 1712 for laying out to me two thousand five hundred Acres of Land in right of Matthew Marks's Original Purchase of five thous^d Acres together with other Land mentioned in the 5^d Warr^t I desire thee to return One thousand Acres Surveyd by David Powel^r ^{on y^e French Creek} above those 30 thousand Acres laid out to Matthew Vincent D^r Cox & Co, Seven hundred thereof to James Pugh & 300 to Simon Meredith to whom I have sold the same.
