



In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Simpson of London dated the 31st day of the 10^{mo} 1733 for the takeing up the Liberty land appurtenant to the original purchase of 10,000 acres in this Province made by William, Margaret, John, & Ann Sharlott Lowthers, There was resurveyd on the 15th of April 1776 (it haveing been survey'd for the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries in the year 1736 by Benj^g Eastburn Survey^r Gen^l) the above described twelve acres of land situate in Blockley Township on the West side of the River Schuylkill, for William Allen Esquire, who purchased of said John Simpson & Informid me he had agreed to convey the same to William Hamilton Esq^r
