


By virtue of a warrant under the hands of the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of Property and y<sup>e</sup> seal of the Province dated y<sup>e</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>br</sup> 1702.

Resurvey'd unto Evan Robert a Tract of land in the Township of Gwanedd in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a corner stake standing by Ellis David's land from thence by a line of marked trees and J<sup>r</sup><sup>s</sup> Hugh's land south forty-three degrees westerly one hundred seventy-six perches to a second stake then by William Johns land north forty-seven degrees westerly one hundred perches to a third stake again by the said William Johns land north forty-three degrees easterly one hundred and seventy-six perches to a ~~third~~ fourth stake thence by the said William Johns land south forty-seven degrees easterly one hundred perches to the place of beginning containing one hundred and ten acres Resurvey'd ~~the~~ by David Powel- Revised in the Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyors Office
