By vertue of a warrant from y<sup>e</sup> Propriet<sup>rs</sup> and Govern<sup>r</sup> bearing date y<sup>e</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1684: directed to me I hereby certifie into his Secretaryes Office y<sup>t</sup> I have caused to be surveyed and laid out y<sup>e</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1684. unto William Rowles Rent<sup>r</sup> a Cobl.) peece or p<sup>ar</sup>cell of land seitate lying and being in y<sup>e</sup> Liberties of y<sup>e</sup> City of Philadelphia Begining at a Corn<sup>r</sup> marked Corn<sup>r</sup> post standing by a swamp side from thence N. 72 Wly by a line of marked trees 53 p<sup>er</sup>ches to a Corn<sup>r</sup> marked hickrey tree from thence N. 18 E. by a line of marked post-12 p<sup>er</sup>ches from thence S. 72 Ely 50 perches to a Cobl.) marked post standing by y<sup>e</sup> afore mentioned swamp from thence down y<sup>e</sup> side thereof to y<sup>e</sup> first mentioned place of begining. Containing and laid out as above for ffour acres of Land and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia (obliterated) <sup>th</sup> of Novemb<sup>r</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> (obl.)
