thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him his proportion  
of Liberty-according to Regulation he seating & empowering the same  
within Six months after y<sup>e</sup> date of survey and make returne hereof  
to y<sup>e</sup> Secretarys Office dated at Philadelphia 19<sup>th</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 1685.
