These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed according to the ancient known lines and bounds thereof the Tract of Liberty Land surveyed and laid out to our late Grandfather Thomas Callowhill since deceased, within the Northern Liberties of Philadelphia in Right and Appurtenant to his original purchases of five thousand five hundred Acres And make Return thereof into our Secretary's Office, and in so doing this shall be thy sufficient Warrant, Given under my Hand and the Seal of Our Land Office at Philadelphia this 31st day of March Anno Dom. 1741.
