I do hereby certify that in pursuance of an Order from Richard Peters Esq^r Secretary to the Honourable the Proprietaries dated the 5th day of May 1750 I have surveyed to W^m Plumsted Esq^r a certain piece of Ground within the City of Philadelphia Beginning at a corner on the east side of the River Schuylkill and on the North side of Pine Street in the said City and extending thence by the 5^d Street Nine Hundred feet thence north seventy-four degrees east Four Hundred and forty-three feet thence north seventy-six degrees West seven Hundred and sixty feet to the said River thence down the same Four Hundred and sixty-four feet to the beginning containing eight acres and sixty-nine perches bounded southward with the said Pine Street eastward & northward wth vacant ground and westward with the said River Schuylkill.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twentieth day of May 190,
